1. The Title :
Environmental Initiatives.
2. Objective of the Practice :
 - i. To reduce climate impact and protection of the environment.
 - ii. To enhance the value of plants and environment among the students through tree plantation drive.
 - iii. To provide much needed shades on campus during summer.
3. The Context :

In a world where environmental degradation is growing concern, its more critical than ever for people to understand the importance of environmental awareness and the role of education in it. This includes reducing waste, conserving resources and getting involved in environmental protection and restoration projects.
4. The Practice :

Environmental protection is the practice of protecting the natural environment by individuals, group and governments. The institution arranged plantation program in collaboration with Forest Department, Bhandara. Composit pits are created for the waste management and rain water harvesting project implemented for irrigation purpose.

Evidence of Success :-

 - Plantation Programe conducted in collaboration with Forest Department. It sensitizes the students to improve environmental conditions.
 - Composit pits are used to make manures and fertile compounds by dumping decaying biodegradable items.
 - The process of collecting and storing rainwater for reuse is done by institution through rain water harvesting.
